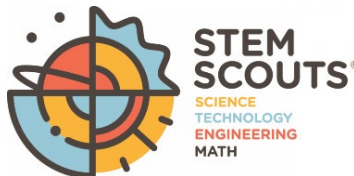
Oak Hill Preschool opens this Fall at CoF
